A 2-Day Workshop on Curriculum Development of PU at KhEC

On 19th and 20th Asar 2079, a 2-Day long Workshop on Curriculum Development was organized by the Faculty of Engineering, Purbanchal University at Khwopa Engineering College under the chairmanship of Prof. Er. Devi Prasad Bhattarai, Dean, Faculty of Engineering, PU. Chief Guest of the Workshop Inauguration Program Mr. Nilmani Pokharel, Registrar, PU, inaugurated the Workshop by lighting the traditional lamp Panas in the presence of distinguished guests including Member of College Management Committee Rabindra Jyakhwo, Chairman, Ward-9, Bhaktapur, Prof. Dr. Jib Raj Pokhrel, Prof. Dr. Binod Bhattari, Prof. Dr. Subarna Shakya, Prof. Dr. Nawaraj Karki. Experts of the subjects in the first year of

engineering programs of PU were involved in the discussion group wise especially in developing micro syllabus and model questions in their respective subjects on the first day, after the inauguration. The new developments and model questions made on the first day were presented to the Dean of the Faculty of Engineering among related experts by the moderator of each team on the second day.



Parents Meeting at KhEC

In those meetings, the Head of the concerned department informed the participant's parents and guardians about the past and ongoing teaching and learning activities while presenting the

agenda at the beginning of the meeting. Similarly, Parents informed the faculty about the efforts made by the students and the new challenges faced by them in the study at home. They also raised queries based on their children's experiences in college. The Heads of departments and specific subject faculty responded to the questions raised in the specific subjects. The queries were finally addressed by Vice-Principal Er. Rabindra Phoju in the same meeting.

The issues and problems gathered from the parents' meeting are being tackled and solved through successive meetings and resultant actions in different tiers of the college administrative mechanisms.
